

LIME, MORTARS, MASONRY & MORE

The Churches Conservation Trust and The Earth Stone and Lime Company are offering a 4 day training course in a variety of traditional building craft skills at All Saints Church, Harewood. Using the whole site as a teaching tool and with a working party theme, practical work will focus on repairing the derelict outbuildings and adjacent walls in the churchyard.



When:

The course will run from Monday 6th until Thursday 9th September 2010. Participants are welcome to attend all or a selection of the days. However we recommend that new participants attend days 1 and 2 to equip them with the knowledge required for the remaining days.

Course Content:

The course is designed to cater for all levels of knowledge from beginners to those with experience. The course leaders are Nigel Copsey and Alex Holton and they along with all other tutors are from companies experienced in historic building repair. Subjects will cover –

Mon: Condition surveys and repair specifications

Tues: Specifications in action – designing and preparing mortars + a plaster demonstration + preparing the building and structures for repair

Wed: Repairs, dressing stone, fixing, pointing

Thurs: Stone slate roofing, leadwork, finishing off

Cost:

£100 per day (or £350 for all 4 days)

Students and unemployed £75 per day (or £250 for all 4 days)

Lunch and refreshments included.
